	But, authors should revised their manuscript to a more organized structure and a more coherent in context.	
	For example, authors review Grossman's theory of health care production (1972) and mention education level as a key input in the production of health outcome. However, authors did not put the country education level or public expenditure of education as an economic factor in the modelling analysis.	
	Some minor errors should be corrected, for example, b1.6% (in last line 3, apge2) may be a error, and #1.27 billion (in line 8, page 3; I have no idea about the # symbol).
