Compulsory REVISION comments	Authors use nominal exchange rate rather than real exchange rate. Discuss what happens when you use the latter. Authors take first difference of the variables and than apply VAR method. Later they use Johasen cointegration test. Explain clearly that for which variables do you use Johansen since it can be used for nonstationary data. The graphs of impulse response seem Vector Error Correction model rather than VAR. I think authors use VEC rather than VAR. Note that VEC needs nonstationary data but VAR needs stationary data. Effect of exchange rate on inflation is negative that is not consistent by theory and should be explained in the text. Effect of interest rate on inflation is also positive that is not usual. Section 4.5 is not related to the overall text. I suggest to remove it. -Clearly indicate which monetary policy tools are used in South Africa in the introduction section briefly.
