<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>The English grammar and syntax need to be improved throughout the text, as well as in the abstract.</p> <p>In general, the author(s) could try to present the procedure clearer analyzing the individual steps and describe in more detail the methods that were chosen supporting their choice. In addition, they could elaborate more on the "Result and Discussion" part.</p> <p>A more extended reference in the geospatial context of the methods is proposed.</p> <p>Figure 1 should be nearer its citation in the text and have a title right underneath.</p> <p>In the beginning of page 3 a word can be used instead of a number (27) to start the sentence.</p> <p>Figure 4 is not mentioned in the text. Furthermore, attention should be paid in Figure's 4 title.</p> <p>Table 1 in not mentioned and explained in the text.</p> <p>The last two images should also be numbered and cited in the text, explaining what they represent.</p> <p>An alternative approach could be to refer to 'Structural management' part before the final Conclusions (the "Discussion-Conclusion" part is mainly presented at the end of a paper) or incorporate 'Structural management' part in the "Discussion" part.</p> <p>References No. 4, 6, 12, 18, 19, 21 are not mentioned in the text. Incorporate those citations in the text.</p>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<p>In order to cite figures in the text use the appropriate uniform symbolism (e.g. "Fig. 1") throughout the entire text.</p> <p>End of page 3: use 'number' instead of 'No'.</p> <p>Check the font type and size to be uniform in the text (check equations).</p> <p>At the end of page 6 change "Desai 199, 2010" with "Desai 1991".</p> <p>Follow a uniform style for the Reference part.</p>	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	<p>Although a great deal of effort was put in this study and the paper is informative regarding forest core demarcation using geospatial techniques, certain improvements should be performed to the manuscript prior to its publication. In addition, a major revision in English grammar and syntax should be done.</p>
