Compulsory REVISION comments	1.The objective was not clearly stated "This study seeks to explore any association if any between handedness in the usage of mobile phone in our environment using a modified Edingburgh Handedness Inventory (EHI).[27]" 2.Although the author used " modified Edingburgh Handedness Inventory" it was not mentioned in the section of method 3. compared this study to another similar study published in JAMA " Hemispheric Dominance and Cell Phone Use" ,where they enrolled 717 participants so the question if it is the number of participants in this study is small , question hence about the power of the study 4.Author did not mentioned the test used for statistical analysis 5. P value is not available when doing the comparison (study is not qualified regarding methodology and statistics)
