

**Editor's Comment:**

I have read carefully both the revised article and the Reviewers' comments. The article is acceptable for publication, provided that the Authors amend ALL the typos (contrarily to their claims in response to one Reviewer, not all the typos have been amended, e.g. the correct spelling for the scientific name of the plant is *Ribes nigrum* (separated, and italicized). Another crucial point: I know very well *Ribes nigrum* (English name: black currant), which develops in temperate/fresh climates, and CANNOT GROW in Nigeria. The Authors should explain in detail the origin of the fruit they have analyzed, or alternatively re-classify correctly them...
