Since this study aimed to measure growth rate between import and export over a 54year period, will would be beneficial to incorporate TIMES SERIES approach to see the changes in this trend. 2. Please check the referencing styles 3. It would be helpful to create a literature review section 4. This manuscript is too short. Many concepts have been mentioned in passing. It can pay off to go deeper in most important information- therefore adding more meat to the manuscript. | <p>1. Time series approach do not fit with this type of research. The aim was to measure trends in export and import by determining growth rate, pattern of growth and doubling time. If the research was interested in determining the factors that influence export and import using time series data, then certainly time series approach involving testing for Stationarity of data would have been performed. This study measures the growth that have occurred within policy periods and suggests that growth (increase and decrease) is as a result of policy reforms within that period.</p> <p>2. This has been corrected.</p> <p>3. The literature on trends on import and export in agricultural products is rather few; hence creating such a section would be too short in my opinion. So I have incorporated and elaborated on the literature in the Introduction section.</p> <p>4. In my opinion I have been deep as should fit a study of this nature.</p> |
