Abstract: "The management of this condition should be through surgical excision and or radiation therapy if removal of tumor and or its metastatic foci is not possible." In this case, you surgically removed the tumor and not used radiation. Thus, you had better describe the "fact" only, deleting the statement as to radiation. 2. Line 73; "mass" 3. Please describe if urinary symptoms and signs were present and if some caution was paid not to injure the lower urinary tract in the surgery. 4. Line 82: "Haematology and Histopathology revealed PCV of 37% and severe smooth muscle tissue proliferation which confirms vaginal leiomyoma. The dog recovered smoothly from anesthesia after the surgery. No post-operative complications were observed. The surgical site healed completely after two weeks and sutures were removed.": This should be moved to "Case last". 5. English should be revised. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Abstract: all statements involving radiation therapy has been deleted as requested. 2. The spelling of mass has been corrected 3. The dog was urinating with no sign of obstruction. The surgery was carried out under extreme careful condition; that is why no postoperative complication was encountered 4. The sentence has been moved 5. The English has been revised
