They can mention it the method section.</li> <li>3) In this study, the authors used rat of either sex. Is it possible to indicate what were the sex of the rat in each group? The best is to use either male or female sex separately in the experiments.</li> <li>4) Is it possible to mention the full form of the abbreviations such as ALT, AST, ALP, ALB, TP and GLO? May be these terms are over used and known to all.</li> <li>5) In figure 1,2,4 and 5 they put a and b in the figures.
