While it is evident that the authors have struggled to meet much of the reviewers' demands, there are still some serious problems in the text that need to be better clarified.</p> <p>4. There are problems with article writing and technical problems involving the methodology, with parts that are not clear.</p> <p>5. The conclusion is poorly written and makes statements that could not be observed merely by analyzing the results obtained at work. Some references are old and could be updated. I am sending back the manuscript attached to this e-mail with my detailed comments. Based on the above I can not recommend publishing the article the way it is.
