I mean do all people with respect to their economic class, religion and education use the same terms	The introduction, I feel, is appropriate and not too lengthy because it has to lead readers to the thrust of the paper. The class of respondents or other sociolinguistic parameters do not have any impact on the data. Similarly, the study is not quantitative in nature.
Minor REVISION comments	The country has millions of muslims, why not to include their terms to enrich the study	Few portions of the Holy Qur'an are quoted to substantiate our points where necessary.
Optional/General comments	To give more examples from Christianity for example and from non religious tribes	We were unable to get examples from non religious tribes because our respondents were not stratified along religious affiliation.
