<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>The article is interesting and useful.</p> <p>The authors must specify if the rats in groups 3 and 4 have received zidovudine or not. This is an important issue.</p> <p>The authors wrote about "The decrease in sleep time seen in the negative control group" but the sleep time increased in this group of rats (2).</p> <p>There are a lot of grammatical errors, as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>the body weight decreased on the average by 1.14g in week 2 and 3.32g in week while...</li> <li>caused the body weight to significantly increased</li> <li>Platelet count was also observed to significantly reduce</li> <li>as well as their possible use haemorrhagic conditions to reduce bleeding without causing thromboembolism.</li> <li>coagulatory effects</li> <li>has necessitated</li> <li>ailments.</li> <li>increasing the synthesis of fibrinogen in plasma (fibrinogen is synthesized in the liver).</li> </ul> <p>The first use of abbreviations should be explained (NRTI and NACO).</p> <p>References are not very recent. The authors must add some new ones.</p>	Thanks for your review. We have looked into them and made the necessary adjustments.
