Maybe worth replacing it with the pharmaceutical title? 	<p>Both patients were not Saudi, and they did not receive the vaccine before. Yes, both cases gave clear history of measles infection. Approximately within the 1st week lumbar puncture done. Thank you, and basically we did Brain MRI, EEG, lumbar puncture, and basic blood investigation. No calculation done, but the titre of anti-body was high in both. The other CSF data: were within normal value. I am working to include MRI scan. We do not have measles treatment protocol, but we reviewed many papers on SSPE, and we read about the effect of such treatment, so we decide to give this medication to our patient.</p>
