They add no information to the tabled content</p> <p>Many references are missing in the list</p>	The full name and then the abbreviations are mentioned. Low and High strata is defined through the Kuppuswamy Index in the methodology. GDM and SSB are defined in the Introduction. All graphs are removed from the manuscript. References have been added.
