<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p><b>Good original research paper very much fit for publication by JEAI. However, the following points should be looked into before the paper is considered for publication.</b></p> <p><b>First and foremost, the geographical coordinates (latitude and longitude) of the area under study should be imperatively highlighted.</b></p> <p><b>Secondly, the data analysis procedure should be well explained and the rationale underlying the use of the statistical analysis software given.</b></p> <p><b>Thirdly, the results and discussion section should be divided into different subsections following the specific objectives of the study. This will ease comprehension of the findings of the study.</b></p> <p><b>Equally, the discussion of the findings of the study should be done in a more comparative fashion i.e. the findings of the study should be compared and contrasted with the findings of other authors who have conducted related research in other parts of the world. This should be done by using the latest publications (2014 – 2019) in the domain in order to give the findings of the study more relevance and depth. Moreover, it is imperative for the author(s) of the paper to provide plausible justifications for the findings of the study and not merely describing the findings.</b></p> <p><b>Last but not the least an insightful conclusion should be given and the possible practical and policy implications of the study should be highlighted.</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Was added the geographic coordinates.</li> <li>- The data analysis procedure was detailed.</li> <li>-The results and the discussion section were divided into different subsections.</li> <li>- In the literature there are no many recent similar works, which makes it difficult to update the references, however I added the reference of Coelho 2017, which was the most recent I found.</li> <li>- The conclusion has been improved based on the objectives and it's easier to understand.</li> </ul>
