Minor REVISION comments	I have seen calculated the accommodation space of the animals, but accommodation means much more than that. It mean volume of air (LxWxh- Length Width Height), watering, type of floor related with leg health. Fodder space, watering space, is enough? If the identification of the architecture of the shelters was the main objective, the building elements could be more detailed. The presence of vertical closure elements (walls- height), windows (surface, the natural lighting coefficient), the presence or absence of doors according to the degree of fire resistance, the presence or absence of the ceiling, the height to the ceiling or the roof, the type of the floor in resting area / shelter, the surface of the walkways, type of ventilation. Shelters are provided or not with inlet, chimney stacks? What is the way in which the vicious air is replaced with the clean air?are aspects that complete the architecture of the shelter and management of accommodation conditions. Even if the shelters do not have all these elements you can consider them. I saw that you made measurements for the shelter.
