Minor REVISION comments	<p>Abstract: Line 8 – Caesarean Section spelling Line 12 – musculoepitoneal</p> <p>Case Study: Line 39 – sections Line 55 – Please restructure the sentence with appropriate grammar usage Line 70 – sutures</p> <p>Discussion: Line 88, 97 – avoid capital words in between sentences Line 101 – 103 – improper sentence structure, please amend Line 101 – use full form when used for the first time, abbreviations (even if standardised) shouldn't be used at first description Line 120 – 121 – tense error, sentence needs restructuring Line 124 - followed like as swabs Line 127 - scar washed wash the wound with</p>
