Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The article is interesting and useful.</p> <p>The authors must specify if the rats in groups 3 and 4 have received zidovudine or not. This is an important issue.</p> <p>The authors wrote about "The decrease in sleep time seen in the negative control group" but the sleep time increased in this group of rats (2).</p> <p>There are a lot of grammatical errors, as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> the body weight decreased on the average by 1.14g in week 2 and 3.32g in week while... caused the body weight to significantly increased Platelet count was also observed to significantly reduce as well as their possible use haemorrhagic conditions to reduce bleeding without causing thromboembolism. coagulatory effects has necessitated ailments. increasing the synthesis of fibrinogen in plasma (fibrinogen is synthesized in the liver). <p>The first use of abbreviations should be explained (NRTI and NACO).</p> <p>References are not very recent. The authors must add some new ones.</p>
