Additionally, a reference could be done regarding the ways that these weaknesses are suggested to be handled.</p> <p>The majority of the references mentioned in the last part are not mentioned in the text. Pay attention to the references and incorporate them in the text where applicable or add new that are capable to support your approach.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	<p>Site your Figures in the text properly.</p> <p>The English grammar and syntax need to be improved in some parts of the text.</p> <p>Use a uniform stile in the References.</p> <p>Correct the first reference (Albek and Ogutveren) in the text.</p> <p>The reference (Saha and Singh, 1991) that is mentioned in the text does not exist in the Reference part.</p>	
Optional/General comments	<p>Although a great deal of effort was put in this study and the paper is informative regarding Hydrological modeling of the Paligad watershed (India) using HSFP model, certain improvements should be performed to the manuscript prior to its publication.</p>
