A large chunk of the discussion is not related to the study. this could be corrected by relating observations to literature or their life cycle</p> <p>5. Delete Fig 1</p> <p>6. Add a Conclusion which should include the major findings of this research.</p>	
Minor REVISION comments	Restructure abstract Introduction and results are too brief. The brevity of results makes it difficult to have a relative discussion	
Optional/General comments	Discussion includes listings of where parasites were found without attempt at explaining similarities or differences There are claims of first observations. These will be valid when literature is updated
