The way it is, one cannot reproduce the study. Provide us with all the information that regards this report. Like what are their age brackets? Diets? Full conditions for the selection of these subjects.</p> <p>The result is difficult to understand and interpret. There is no point combining the mean and sd of all groups as seen in table 1 as you were expected to compare from the title.</p> <p>Secondly, the table 2, the number are not all the same, did you use all the subjects? Why not report individual group result. This will lead to the removal of table 1 but present the study better. Table 2 cannot be easily comprehended.</p> <p>This has affected the discussion section.</p> <p>The conclusion is to be revised. Focus on the outcome of the comparative studies and not the liver enzymes.</p>
