You state in Discussion, "Although the psychological impacts of pregnancy termination due to fetal anomaly has been studied before but the specific needs and the required support for this population has not yet fully determined." You also state in Introduction that such study has not yet been performed in "Iran". Then, in other countries other than Iran, such kind of study has been already performed: the context indicates so. Then, please cite some references. Please write whether you will make (have made) some contrivance that is "Iran specific".
