Editor's Comment:

I found the article had been reviewed by few reviewers.

The article contained some valuable information related to resistance pattern, which is very useful for clinical information. Some more, the data was done in private hospital, which is usually not a common place which is utilised as place of data collection.

However, I had few major comments for the article.

- 1) The corrected version have many spelling errors particularly *Salmonella typhi* and *S.paratyphi* ..which should be written in italic. There so many typos as well that need attention.
- 2) The study is not pilot or cross sectional study; it is a case report of antimicrobial resistance in private practice setting.
- 3) Validity and reliability of the data should be explained in one paragraph.
- 4) For descriptive data, authors can also utilised microsoft excel; current version of IBM SPSS is version 25.0 meaning version 20.0 is actually no longer available. Yhe report of using it meaning this data obsolete or perhaps the software is not a genuine one.

To me, my decision is major corrections.
