## **Editor's Comment:**

The below mentioned paper is interesting and potentially could be published in JAMB, but in revised version 1 of the manuscript the Authors included only a part of suggestions of the reviewer Edl and none suggestions of reviewer Gam without answers to the comments that have not been included, though the answers to all reviewers comments are compulsory. Moreover in my opinion some additional minor revisions presented below should be made in the revised version of manuscript before acceptation for publication.

In last paragraph of the Abstract a short conclusion should be included.

In keywords list a phrase internally displaced infants should be used instead of IDP.

In "Methodology" chapter the volume of milk and urine collected from each sample as well as the number of replicates of each sample are still lacking.

In "High performance liquid Chromatography (HPLC), Analysis for Aflatoxin  $M_1$ " subchapter the concentrations of AFM $_1$  used to construct the calibration curve are still lacking, moreover last paragraph of this subchapter a phrase AFM $_1$  instead of AF  $M_1$  should be used.

It is not clear if in the caption of figure 1 the units of concentration should be  $ng/\mu L$ , or  $\mu g/mL$  or  $\mu g/L$ , as the units in the text are different as compared to values in the caption and in the table 1.

The description of table 1. should be corrected as below:
