Compulsory REVISION comments	In this article, the authors isolated lactic acid bacteria from fermented Parkia biglobosa seeds, using conventional phenotypic microbiologic techniques. This approach is limited to culturable bacteria, and current metagenomic approaches allow the complete characterization of all kinds of bacteria; this would increase the resolution of the analysis. If the authors are not able to perform a metagenomic approach, they should at least discuss the possibility, advantages, and future perspectives. Minor REVISION comments	The manuscript needs some English revision, it contains some grammar mistakes and some typos (for example in the abstract: "All isolates <u>expect</u> TEB were negative..."
