They should properly rework the abstract not to exceed the 300 words as well as give definitions for Acronyms and Abbreviations in the first time these are reported. Because there are some grammatical mistakes, the authors should conduct a language editing.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ <b>Theoretical framework is not treated like empirical review. It explains the theory on which basis the study was carried out. It also provides the framework theoretically, to support the given study. The review of literature or empirical studies is not relevant in the explanation of the concept of theoretical framework. It should be noted that model specification for this study is derived from the subsection (theoretical literature)</b></li><li>➤ <b>Abstract is now less than 300 words</b></li><li>➤ <b>Acronyms and Abbreviations are written fully in the first mention</b></li><li>➤ <b>Issue of grammatical mistakes has been tackled</b></li></ul>
