Please explain in detail the mechanism of Sodium or calcium polystyrene sulfonate (Resonium) , and polystyrene sulfonate. Reference Abraham et al <sup>7</sup> suggested sorbitol causes intestinal injury. Authors explain how both sorbitol and SPS causes intestinal injury and induces inflammatory markers. Please include the related references.	Thank you for your kind suggestion. The mechanism of action of Sodium or calcium polystyrene sulfonate has been described in the 2 <sup>nd</sup> paragraph of the discussion part. I have added a bit more about the exact chemical composition of that drug to that paragraph.  The drug, Resonium, used in our hospital is free of Sorbitol. Hence, this case also proves that Sorbitol is not the sole agent responsible or causing intestinal necrosis.
