Compulsory REVISION comments	The manuscript is poorly written and often hard to follow. The singular pronoun 'it' is often used to represent the plural noun 'mangas.' I have suggested a number of corrections in the attached copy of the manuscript. Line 4 – “The manga industry has taken the world by storm since the early 20th century.” This should be “the late 20th century.” Line 88 – The first line of this paragraph does not relate to the rest of the paragraph. The missing link seems to be something like “Yet comics were stigmatized long before mangas came on the scene.” Line 100 - There was a steep decline in 1956-1957, and then a recovery to earlier sales figures. From 1968 onwards comic book sales went into a gradual decline, probably for demographic reasons (the baby boom generation was getting older, and succeeding generations were much smaller in size). http://www.zak-site.com/Great-American-Novel/comic_sales.html Line 105 – The CCA lost its power in the 1970s.
