<p>I am not sure what to say because some of my comments haven't been really addressed and in the author's answers there is just "corrected" with no explanation, so it is complicated for me to give an evaluation of the corrections.</p> <p>The only part that they try to explain is the one on the sample size. However, they cite a certain author providing a formula but there is no reference on that formula. On top of that, the numbers seem to be made up to justify their sample size of 72, because they write:</p> <p>"e is the standard error of 5%."</p> <p>but the standard error is an absolute quantity not a percentage and if they have a standard error in absolute value of 0.05, that is impossible because it means that all the shoes were of the same size.</p>	<p>corrected</p>
