<p>In my opinion, the authors do not respond adequately to the previous comments.</p> <p>The main points remain:</p> <p>1.-The display of all statistical parameters regarding the size of the samples that are compared, is not an option, it is totally mandatory, to estimate the credibility of the results. If the authors do not do it, they should write it in the text, so that the reader has the appropriate information.</p> <p>2.-Likewise, the use of a questionnaire without having demonstrated that it is reliable and valid, makes the results worthless. Authors should write in in the Methods section "that the reliability and validity of the questionnaire is not known."</p> <p>On the other hand:</p> <p>Keywords should be modified</p> <p>The authors must indicate in the new text, in another color, the changes made, in order to evaluate the new corrected manuscript without errors.</p>	<p>Again the authors would like to thank the reviewer for his/her feedback!</p> <p>1.
