<u>Compulsory</u> REVISION comments	The manuscript is a descriptive retrospective study focused on the association of thyroid disorders diagnosed histologically with age and sex. The study would potentially contribute to the field of research on etiopathogenesis of thyroid disorders and the comprehension of the main risk factors, however it need some improvements. Overall, I recommend a revision of the text from an English mother-tongue due to the presence of a number of grammar errors. The abstract is too long. I suggest the authors to abbreviate, in particular, the section concerning methods. Moreover, the study country should be added. In the text, within the Methods section, the authors should specify whether the study was approved by the Ethics Committee and provide details of authorization. In Results section, please check that Thyroiditis (Hashimoto) cases are males, since in table 2 are reported as females.	<b>All corrections were highlighted in yellow.</b> ABSTRACT -The abstract was reduced in size to 247 words. METHODOLOGY -It was not possible to abbreviate the write up in this section as the possible words were occurring therein for the first time. -Methodology LINE 2: The study country "Nigeria" was inserted (also inserted in ABSTRACT line 5, and DISCUSSION paragraph 5 line 4). -There were no ethical concerns with the study. RESULTS -Paragraph 5 line 5: "males" was changed to "females", such that all Hashimoto thyroiditis cases were seen in females.
<u>Minor</u> REVISION comments	In Results, consider to write "thyroglossal cyst" instead of "thyroglossal cyst"	-RESULTS Paragraph 3, Lines 1 and 3, and Tables 1 and 2: "Thyroglossal" was corrected to "Thyroglossal". ****GRAMMATICAL ERRORS***** -The article was re-read to address this challenge and the resultant corrections constituted all other words/phrases highlighted in <b>yellow</b> .
