EDITORIAL COMMENTS:

- 1) Reviewers agree that the topic of the paper is interesting and the results are important.
- 2) Reviewers are ok with the publication of the paper under the condition that it should be given to <u>"a native of English speaker for proofreading and corrections"</u>.
- 3) Citation and references should be sequenced (exp. [1], [2], [3],...), as they appear in the paper and be relevant to the topic being discussed.
- 4) The reference list should be formatted according to current scientific research paper standards.
- 5) The paper is not well formatted. There is no spacing between paragraphs. The font should be changed, etc. Must check the formatting guidelines of the journal.

My editorial decision is: Paper should be accepted for publication <u>after major</u> formatting and English corrections.
