Tuber produced from V3M4, contained maximum ascorbic acid (Vitamin C), antioxidant and polyphenol; whereas the V1M1 was exhibited worst one. In conclusion, the potato growers of Bangladesh may apply vermicompost on their field at the rate of 6 tons per hectare for better yield and processing quality in combination of Asterix and Courage; can also store at ambient condition up to 60 days after storage (DAS).
