The shape of the scleral flap is not mentioned, only dimensions Data about cataract progression and management is not presented.	We revised manuscript for English grammar We included to the study patients with mild visual field defects ( <a href="#">grades between 5-7 according to Quigley's classification</a> ). Flap is prepared triangular shaped. In fact we had data about cataract progression, however we exclude these data to avoid complicating the manuscript too much.
