Compulsory REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Line 49 repeats the contents of the above lines. -Paragraph beginning line 68 to 75 should be redone. The aim of the Law of the Child should be succinct. There is no need to repeat the objectives of the study in this paragraph since they were highlighted already. -Paragraph (line 94-103) repeats the contents of the preceding paragraph. The author should synchronise these paragraphs. -The author needs to explain Fig 1 clearly. There is need to explain the meaning of the direction arrows. The author is advised to think of other ways of presenting this information. -The writer should give more details on how cross-sectional research design was used in this study - Sampling and sample size- how many key informants were interviewed? - Line 204- The author should give explanation on why UNICEF's findings differ from the findings of this study. When did UNICEF conduct the study? Could it be that the child justice system is improving? -Courts give orders related to child counseling and community- I suggest that this sub-title should be changed to "Court orders. The author should explain the implications of these court orders in the child rights discourse. -Case proceedings pertaining to street children- I suggest that this sub-title should be changed, may to something like " court appearance and efficiency" Ethical Issue: The author should mention how the consent of children was obtained in order for them to participate in the survey. 	
Minor REVISION comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -There is need to quote the name of the author(s) and year in the article rather than giving a reference number -Line 46- grammatical error. "is" to change to "was" -Lines 64 and 65 have grammatical errors, should be in the present tense form. -In line 117, the word "projected" should be replaced by "estimated" -Line 120- the author should highlight what attracts children to be on the streets in the selected municipalities. -Line 146- to written in the past tense form. -SPSS to be written in full (Statistical Package for Social Studies) -Lines 194 and 195 should be revisited in order to correct grammatical errors. -Lines 200 and 201 should be rewritten- there are grammatical errors -Lines 306-307 should be rewritten because of grammatical errors -Paragraph beginning line 353 needs to be done again because of numerous grammatical errors. -Foster care- is there legal provision for foster care in Tanzania? 	
Optional/General comments	I suggest that the title of the article to be changed to, "Justice delivery to street children on the streets: A case study of Dar Es Salaam, Tanzania" or "The role of law enforcement agents in protecting the rights of street children: A case study of Dar Es Salaam, Tanzania"
