Before it is considered for publication, it must be re-read by a qualified editor whose native language is English who can correct the faulty grammar. In particular, the recurrent phrase &lt;&lt;from far off the city&gt;&gt; must be changed to 'far from the city'.</p> <p>In its current form,, the manuscript is primarily a statistical report which does not warrant publication. The cited food plant species represent only a data base of common home grown food plants in the region studied. While the authors acknowledge the role of home garden-grown foods in combating micronutrient malnutrition. they have failed to provide any data on the nutrient content of the foods they have recorded. What is required to make this paper publishable will be the addition of nutrient content and values data, for each plant as well as information from local health clinics regarding the forms of malnutrition, in the study area. This will give homemakers a scientific basis for selecting those foods in their gardens which will provide the nutrients needed to eliminate local micronutrient deficiencies.</p> <p>The authors have included useful information regarding methods of dealing with plant pests and diseases; however, they have neglected to mention agricultural extension services, which are a valuable resource for other issues, which the home gardener may encounter.</p> <p>4,. The Latin (Linnean) binomials, for all plants cited, must be provided together with local common names.&gt;&gt;</p> <p>It will be necessary, for the author/s, to define specifically, in kilometers,, what 'the exact distance is when 'far from the city' is stated.</p>
