<p>Please: Introduce a map indicating the position of the concerned zone and its geographical characteristics.</p> <p>Line 12: Department we collected the data: correct to <i>Department we collected</i></p> <p>Line 17: add to key words: Rainfall classification</p> <p>Lines 32-38: please introduce references</p> <p>Line 38: Remove Temperature from the sentence " Rainfall in Tamil Nadu during the period of 2007 to 2013" because you spoke about the rainfall only !</p> <p>Lines 55 -57: rewrite the paragraph as following: The main objective of the present study is to identify the pattern and perform a seasonal rainfall classification over Tamil Nadu as well as to analyse the import and export operations of the agricultural products during (2007 – 2013) in India.</p> <p>Line 66: Add a methodology section and write clearly the classification approach used. The methodology and the approach are not understandable!</p> <p>Lines 67-68: rewrite as following: "In 2007, there are three clusters fully formed while a significant difference in rainfall characteristics is identified in October, November and Decembers."</p> <p>Line 134: correct the word: " rail fall" to "Rainfall" as I have already mentioned in my last review</p> <p>Lines 180-185: Explain why you introduced import/export of agricultural products and what is its relationship with the classification of the rainfall regimes in the region. Please do an analysis to find out the relationship you are speaking about!!</p> <p>Conclusion: should mainly be based on Rainfall classification than agricultural products import-export!!</p> <p>My Statement: The language is a bit challenging to understand.
