<b>Compulsory</b> REVISION comments	<p>The information in the paper can be used as the Background to develop a strong paper with interesting findings. The findings are not unique.</p> <p>Such challenges of information asymmetry exist at farming levels in many countries and for almost all crop types. (How is this case of potato farmers in UP different??)</p> <p>Many applications of ICT (or IOT) are now coming into practice, such best practices should be covered in literature review. Missing literature review and more references needed. Many advancements have taken place for establishing better connectivity within farming communities, include those references, or include in conclusion as way forward.</p> <p>The language has to be checked throughout the paper and re-written for a better readability at par with international journal standards.</p> <p>The structure for the paper should begin with introduction, study area, methodology, ( no materials used or specified , the heading material and methods is irrelevant)</p> <p>Introduction should be well structured, if not starting from global, at least national level details/ review/ background.</p> <p>Too much of repetition, abstract, introduction and conclusion is the same.</p> <p>Also table info and description of the table is redundant (Table 2 and line 63-71), need further explanation, or some comparison with other districts/ states /countries growing potatoes would make it interesting.</p> <p>Table 2: Sr.No 4: expanses?? Sr.No 8: Lbours?? Kindly have the language checked before paper submission.</p> <p>Line 29: Fifth in production, what is the fourth</p>
