Minor REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Since the cost efficiency is not dealt with, it is no necessary to describe it in line 144 to 146. 2. Figure 2 is not well-prepared, please redraw. 3. In line 316, ln will be better than Ln. 4. Line 330, it should be Kumbhakar and Lovell (2000). 5. To simplify and make Figure 3 readable, it is no need to show "Households using x kg to y kg fertilizers," just showing x kg to y kg and percentage will be enough. 6. Cobb Douglas in page 392 is repeated. 7. The unit of seeds in line 397 remains unclear. 8. Line 303, it should be technical inefficiency. 9. Line 324, it should be ε_i (subscript), rather than εi 10. Line 422, it should be Table 3, rather than Table 13. 11. Table 3 indicates that the sample size (N) is 1071, but in Appendix Table 2, why there are 1086 males and 170 females. 12. Why so many variables with minimum of zero? Is there any problem with data? 13. It is recommended to display the estimation results in the text, rather than in Appendix.
