Compulsory REVISION comments	The paper is important as it provides information to improve the productivity of the olive tree in Egypt. The objective of work is clear and precise. In the materials and methods in Table 2, the units of the water analysis are not listed, it is not known if they are meq / l or mg / l. The materials and methods are very well described and very detailed In the section Surface area of the canopy (m ²), it is stated that "the genotype of the olive tree (61 and 91) detected the greatest increase in the surface area of the canopy in the first and second seasons, respectively" which is not true the statistical point of view since there is no difference between the genotype 91, 97 and 25 in 2016 and in 2017 the 97 and 25 have no differences. The results are presented in a very complete way, unlike the conclusions that are very poor, no reference is made to the possible differences between years for the same crop due to meteorological conditions.	
Minor REVISION comments	The paper in general is well presented, we must review the interpretation of some results that do not match the data in the tables, which is surely an error due to the large amount of information to be analyzed. The conclusions should also be reformulated
