The statistical method have to be given.</p> <p>Obsevation and analyses: It is better to give SD with mean age.</p> <p>Discussion: Very very short. Have to be re-written.</p> <p>Conclusion: Second paragraph could be placed at the discussion section.</p> <p>References: There are a lot of mistakes. They have to be corrected.</p> <p>Figures: There are problems with numbers of figures. Please correct.</p> <p>Graph: Is it true '5000%'</p>
