With refer to Planck scale, Mach's relation, support for large scale cosmic anisotropy and preferred directions, and two new parameters, which are Gamma and Beta, the ordinary matter density ratio, dark matter density ratio, mass, radius, temperature, age and expansion velocity are estimated. Some suggestions about the Planck universe with dark foam are given. Overall, the content of the paper is well discussed. However, the presentation of the paper shall be further improved. Some comments are given as follow.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Too many keywords are given, normally, in a research paper, at most FIVE (5) keywords are provided.</li> <li>2. Does the term "Big Bang" is a special name? If NOT, please write the term "big bang" consistently in the text, do not write "Big Bang" and "big bang" together in the text.</li> <li>3. In Page 2, see "For the above symbols, subscript 0 denotes...", do not see any subscript 0, only subscript t. Please check.</li> <li>4. The caption for Figures 1, 2, 3 shall be put at the bottom of the figure, not putting at the top of the figure.</li> <li>5. The caption for Table 1 shall be put at the top of the table, not putting in the table.</li> <li>6. In Page 7, what does CMBR stand for? Please give the full name before using the acronym.</li> <li>7. Please write the references in a correct format. Do not understand why many reference articles are in single page. Please check.</li> </ol>	
<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. When some examples are mentioned in the text, please do not end with "etc".</li> <li>2. Please write "Figure 1" in the text rather than using "figure 1". The same comment for Figures 2 and 3. Also, write "Table 1" instead of writing "table 1".</li> <li>3. This is a research paper, but some sections are written in a point form (1), (2), .... See Sections 2.4, 4 and 10. It is suggested to write the paper into a paragraph form.</li> <li>4. There are some grammatical mistakes, please do the correction carefully.</li> </ol>
