Since you used Streptozotocin to destroy the beta cells of pancreas, you worked with type 1 DM and should not have expected the effect of the plant and the standard drug, Glibenclamide in increasing insulin release. What cells which are not the beta cells of pancreas could release insulin? You should consider other mechanism of action of Glibenclamide in reducing blood glucose and use these mechanisms to discuss your data.
