Compulsory REVISION comments	The experiments have been well described and organized in manuscript. However, the limited data acquired in this study far from evaluation the quality of the produced alcohol-free beer and wine. My suggestion is: 1) trying to increase biochemical data as much as possible, such as total sugar, total phenols, anti-oxidative abilities and so on that could be giving an overall evaluation to the products; 2) providing a sensory evaluation results to the products, are these alcohol-free smell/taste good or acceptable or disgusting; and 3) discuss in detail the possible method to make acceptable alcohol-free beer and wine, based on the relationship between removing of ethanol and the volatile substances and losing of sensory quality. The tittle is not well represent the manuscript contents, both the production, evaluation and tropic raw material are not the key points of the manuscript. A biochemical comparative study of juice, alcohol and alcohol-free beer and wine may be better. The method proposed in this manuscript cannot produce real sense alcohol wine. The concept of alcohol-free wine is drink which contains maximum 0,5 % of alcohol and all aromatic substances contained in wine. Therefore the concept of alcohol-free wine or beer cannot be used here in the manuscript.
