Why do you not mention them in the caption?</p> <p>-Annotations of lithology, aquifer, bitumen etc. should be done on the figures themselves or at least on one of the figures so that the figures speak for themselves.</p> <p>-In the conclusions, you have referred to other papers. This is not the way to write conclusions. Those references (3 and 5) you made in the conclusions should be put in the introduction.</p> <p><b>-Look at my comments in yellow within the text of the paper</b></p>
