Compulsory REVISION comments	<p>The authors discussed a case of mid shaft fracture in an eight-year-old with haemophilia A disease. The boy got the complication by the use of intramuscular injection by a private facility. Also, they described that the boy received blood transfusion with packed red cells and fresh frozen plasma. These managements are not the ideal treatment plan for haemophiliacs (page 6, lines 112-115). The authors indicated that they could not return the boy to full health as soon as possible. It was because of delay in presentation to UCH, the delay in accessing adequate rFVIII concentrate, and the cost implications. The authors suggest that there is a need to make recombinant factor VIII concentrate more readily available and inexpensive to patients with haemophilia. This manuscript is an interesting case to manage a haemophilia disease in developing countries in particular. Yet, it needs massive revision to be accepted for publication in this journal. For example, they need to rewrite the abstract. An abstract should be a summary of the manuscript and where are the keywords? Also, the authors should use General Guideline for Authors from SDI in presenting this manuscript.</p> <p>Other points:</p> <p>There are too many passive voices in this manuscript. The authors should the use active voice, if possible. For example, page 1, lines 12-14: "He initially presented at a private facility where his management was complicated by the use of intramuscular injection before he was referred to our tertiary health care centre." It is a long sentence and passive voice. I suggest, "He initially presented at a private facility where he experienced mismanagement by the use of intramuscular injection before coming to our tertiary health care center."</p> <p>The authors should provide the prevalence of haemophilia A and should add at least two new references in the Introduction section. These references can include doi:10.9734/JABB/2017/35111 and doi:10.1186/s13287-019-1138-8. Rewrite the paragraph for clarity.</p> <p>This manuscript should have a table for coagulation tests in the Case Report section. These can include prothrombin time (PT) and activated prothrombin time (APTT). The authors can use this reference (doi:10.1177/1179545X18821158), or other references, in providing the table.</p> <p>Correct spelling mistakes. For example, Page 1, line 11: "eight year old" to "eight-year-old" Page 2, line 46: "5yearsage" to "5 years old" Page 3, line 65: "7units;" etc. Rewrite captions for Figures 1-5. For example, "x ray" to "X-ray"</p> <p>A conclusion should be to highlight and summary of the most important points of the manuscript.</p>
