<b>Minor</b> REVISION comments	1. If <i>A. gambiae</i> mosquitoes fly near the eaves, why not use higher insecticide-treated net-fences in order to avoid their entrance into the shelters? Or else why not change the insecticide? As it is, it seems that those treated net-fences are ineffective for <i>A. gambiae</i> and, thus, for <i>Plasmodium falciparum</i> .	
<b>Optional/General</b> comments	In my opinion, the paper is worth to be published, but other models should be tried and improved for use against <i>A. gambiae</i> . The work is interesting and adds interesting material to scientific discussion in this field.
