Schneider, P., Bousema, J., Gouagna, L., Otieno, S., van de Vegte-Bolmer, M., Omar, S. Submicroscopic Plasmodium falciparum gametocyte densities frequently result in mosquito infection. Am J Trop Med Hyg. 2007;76:470-474.	
Minor REVISION comments	There are lots for typographic errors, mainly "joined words" in lines 22, 25, 28, 44, 46, 59, 60, 61, 66 etc. The write-up should be reviewed to correct these typographic errors. Lines 289-302 should be removed from the write-up, as ethical issue has been mentioned earlier in the write-up.
