Compulsory REVISION comments	The goal of this work was to investigate the antibacterial and antifungal potential of the essential oils extracted from R. <i>officinalis and P. citrosum</i> against Gram-positive bacteria (<i>Staphylococcus aureus, Bacillus subtilis</i>) and Gram-negative bacteria (<i>Pseudomonus aeruginosa, Escherichia coli</i>) and fungus (<i>Candida albicans</i>). Scientifically robust and technically sound work, important results were obtained but with insufficient description of important the experimental part, especially part Antimicrobial assay . The definition of the concentration of used EO should be described as well more exactly. For more details see yellowed notes directly in the manuscript.
