<p>In the second version of the manuscript, I see that the authors have partly fulfilled the recommended changes;</p> <p><b>1) Abstract</b>  --Results: No mention of the results of the statistical analysis (chi-square) can be found.  --Conclusion: It also indicated that replacements were more prevalent ... for individuals brushing once daily in comparison with those brushing twice daily What about the occasionally-brushing patients? Actually they are not few, and their results should be included.</p> <p><b>2) Materials and Method</b>  --Instead of giving the inclusion criteria as: "Age groups: 15-30 years, 30-45 years, 45-60 years, 60 and above", present it simply as patients aged <math>\geq 15</math> years. What the authors did is stratification. Mention the stratification elsewhere in the text. Not in the inclusion criteria section.</p> <p><b>3) Results</b>  -- Table 3, What does the p value mean? They are not described in the Results section. What should one understand by seeing those p values? There is no reference to the statistical analysis in the text to the statistics shown in the Table 3.  -- Table 1, Add total rows</p> <p><b>4) References</b>  -- There are no more repetitive references. But, the references list does not match with the main text and the referencing style is wrong or not standardized. There are many wrongly cited author names or article titles.</p> <p><b>5) The authors are always expected to respond point-by-point to the Reviewers' suggestions.</b></p>
