We don't know the clinical and the radiographic phenotypes of the pelvis and the lumbar area? It seems a big adventure operating on joints in patients with osteoporosis with obesity.. Especially, in severe cases, surgeons are dealing with fragile and fragmented bones which are easily get infected. Authors need to provide the bone density results of this patient. Authors are also need to read the paper published by Ortiz-Neu et al (Bone and joint infection Due to Salmonella, J of infe. Dis.1978). Salmonella typhimurium and Salmonella enteritidis as were the most common serotypes involved with bone infections.
